Sandwich and Sandwich Bay


From the historic Cinque Port of Sandwich this easy, level walk follows the River Stour before heading across rough pasture to the breezy shores of Sandwich Bay. The return route crosses famous Royal St George's Golf Course, which has hosted numerous Open Championships, and passes through Sandwich Bay Nature Reserve. Take your binoculars and visit the bird observatory to find out the day's migrant sightings.

Sandwich

Exuding great charm and character, Sandwich is the oldest Cinque Port and stands on the River Stour, though the sea is now 2 miles (3.2km) away. Reminders of the Flemish weavers, who landed in Kent at the end of the 16th century, abound in the form of superb timbered houses and inns that can be seen in the town. The Barbican, a medieval conical-towered gate, and Fishergate remain and other notable buildings include St Clement's Church, which has a fine Norman tower and displays carvings of the same period, and the Old House is a fine Tudor building.

 Head east on a traffic-free tarmac road, parallel with the River Stour, away from the town. On nearing houses, bear left across a footbridge to join a narrow surfaced path that affords good river views. Keep left at the fork of paths to follow the meandering tarmac path close to the river.

Eventually, cross a sluice gate to reach the road and bear left for a few paces to cross the waymarked stile on the right. Follow the defined path across rough grassland to reach a stile. Do not cross the stile, instead, walk beside the fencing, following it left before bearing diagonally right with the good

path, heading across grassland towards the right-hand edge of a line of fir trees. At the trees, go through the kissing-gate and continue towards buildings, with St George's Golf Course to the right and good views left to Ramsgate. Merge with a track coming in from the left and follow it to the coast road at Sandwich Bay A.

Turn right, then at the car park and toilets, bear left to join a track that heads south close to the pebble beach.




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


