# Godstone

**Start** Village pond, Godstone

**Distance** 4 miles (6.4km)

**Height gain** 260 feet (80m)

**Approximate time** 2 hours

**Parking** Next to the village pond (3 hours maximum stay)

**Route terrain** Bridleway, farmland footpaths

**Dog friendly** Keep on a lead through Godstone Farm

**Ordnance Survey maps** Landranger 187 (Dorking & Reigate), Explorer 146 (Dorking, Boxhill and Reigate)


*An easy walk that passes an historic nature reserve, once a site used in the making of gunpowder, and goes through some attractive farmland on the edge of Godstone. The latter half follows the Greensand Way. The Pond at Godstone Green was used as a horse pond in the 19th century and waggoners would drive their horses down its sloping bank.*

 From the pond cross the road, take the public footpath beside the **White Hart** pub in the direction of the church. Pass beside Bay Pond and its nature reserve, which was originally built to power the local gunpowder mill at nearby Leigh Mill, then cross the road ahead and follow the footpath to the right of St Nicholas churchyard.

*The Greensand Way, near Godstone*



This is a quiet area known as Church Town, and it has many old timber-framed buildings. Church End and Church House, both opposite the church are examples of buildings erected when brick became fashionable in the 18th century. As well as restoring the church Sir George Gilbert Scott also designed

right along a cross-field path.


At the other end bear left through a narrow belt of trees past a waymark post (path can be overgrown along this section) to a concrete bridge over the River Mole. Do not cross this bridge but turn right in front of it and climb an embankment to a three-way footpath junction **D**.

Turn left, following the hedge line and where it curves left, keep ahead across the field towards a copse. Cross the footbridge and bear half right across

the field ahead, passing to the right of a large oak tree. Maintain this direction to go through a hedge gap and kissing-gate at a public footpath sign and then climb the stile and bear left diagonally across the field, to reach a stile beside a set of yellow waymarkers. Climb the stile and keep beside the hedge on the right across two fields, then continue along a track towards a farmhouse to a road.

Cross the road, climb the stile by a public footpath sign opposite and continue ahead to climb another stile and a plank footbridge.

Turn right and go through a hedge gap by a yellow waymarker then bear slightly left across the field. Leigh Place with its moat and medieval fishponds is over to the right. Go through a kissing-gate in the corner of the field and turn left along the road back to the church. ●




